

The following policy regarding animal control in the community of Harbor Lakes has been adopted by the Board of Directors of the Harbor Lakes Homeowners Association.

Any resident having a complaint against any animal and its owner in this community will be governed by the following City of Granbury guidelines:

A person who is disturbed by an animal that unreasonably barks, howls, makes other unreasonable noise, is allowed to roam unleashed or litters near a private residence or common area of Harbor Lakes may file a complaint with the Granbury Police Department (817-573-2648). A complaint must include the name and address of the complainant, the exact address of the disturbance, the type of animal causing the disturbance and the times that the animal is causing the disturbance.

The Police Department will direct the Animal Control Officer to hand deliver or mail the owner of the animal a written notice that a disturbance complaint has been received. A copy of the notice shall be mailed to the complainant.

If an owner continues to allow his animal to cause a disturbance, the complainant may file a complaint in writing with the municipal court.
